- "I have been there a month and never received a referral."
- "There weren't enough people at the group."

What they always fail to mention is that they:

- didn't interact with the group effectively they were just there to see what they could get;
- never brought anyone new to the group;
- never gave any referrals or made anyone else feel like a referral was due;
- would only turn up now and again.

These are the people who are not serious about networking and are always the first to criticise networking events.
